DECEMBER ATTENDANCE:

Our overall school attendance for the month of December was 93.35%. Drop off and Pick Up Safety:

The safety of our children is a major concern every year. It is important to follow all traffic laws and to be considerate of all students, staff, and neighbors. During the morning drop off, drive along Parnell and stop at the curb to drop off your children. Do not park along Parnell in the mornings. You do not need to get out of your car because patrol students and staff are there to assist your child out of the car and into the building. During pick up, Parnell is closed to all traffic at 2:30pm. If you are parked on Parnell, you will need to remain parked until cars are released (approximately 2:55pm). This is to ensure all students are able to safely exit the buildings and grounds. There is no double parking around the school. Double parking and leaving your car unattended is illegal. Do not drive through the alleys around school and/or park your car in any of the restricted areas: alleys, Parnell west side, Wallace east side. This is not only dangerous, but you may be issued a ticket for leaving/abandoning your vehicle. Continue to be careful and vigilant as your drive your car near the school. Please report unsafe drivers or individuals to the school office or the Chicago Police Department.
