## NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION:

New student registration continues. Children who will be five years old by September 1 may attend kindergarten. Registration is by appointment only. Parents/Guardians can register on the Healy website to schedule an appointment. The following documents are **required** for registration:

- 1) Driver's License or Picture ID of parent/legal guardian
- 2) 2 proofs of residency (gas, light, phone bills are acceptable) These must be in the name of the parent/legal guardian
- 3) Original Birth Certificate
- 4) Health Records (a recent health exam is **required**)
- 5) IEP or 504 related papers (if **applicable**)
