Congratulations! Your child has successfully completed the 5th grade and is now prepared to enter 6th grade. We encourage you to have your child review the skills they learned in 5th grade over the summer. It is very important that they have memorized their multiplication facts, and continue to practice multiplication and division over the summer. We also suggest reading for at least 30 minutes each day. Take advantage of the wonderful museums and parks our city has to offer. These experiences will help your child strengthen their skills for a successful school year.

The following is a list of highly recommended supplies that students will use throughout the year.

- 2 Three-subject notebooks (one each: red and blue) ****might need to be replaced mid-way through the year****
- 2 One inch binders
- Binder dividers
- 2 two-pocket plastic folders
- 3 packs of 3 x 5 lined index cards
- 4 x 6 lined index cards
- 2 packages of Post-it Notes (any color)
- 2 Composition journals (one black, one color of choice)
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 erasers
- 5 highlighters (yellow, pink, orange, green, blue)
- 2 package of notebook paper
- 1 pencil case (**NO PENCIL BOXES ALLOWED**- they don't fit into the desk)
- 6 Bic pens (black or blue)
- 4 red pens (*****used to correct, very important**)
- 1 package of pencils
- 4 glue sticks
- Pack of Multi- color pens

The following items are suggestions, but also highly recommended. The school does not provide these items. We appreciate you sending these items with your child.

- 1 Scientific calculator (Texas Instruments TI30xa or TI30 IIs)
- 1 container of Clorox wipes
- Ziploc bags - boys:gallon size
girls: sandwich size
